- **Short Introduction with Brief History of the Department :**

The department of Economics started its journey with an Honours degree course in the year 1983-1984 with four dedicated teaching faculty members, although the introduction of Pass Course in the subject may be traced back to 1953-1954. Since then the department has been running with all its achievements in the academic field. At present the department nurtures about 69 Honours students and hosts three teaching faculty members who are involved in various academic activities including research. Right from its inception the department has been producing meritorious students who have claimed high scores at the UG level under the University of Burdwan, reaching across different parts of the nation, with the course of time, pursuing with their career. As of today, the department continues with its earlier heritage, laying down a list of toppers under the Sidho-Kanho-Birsha University at the UG level.
